Take a walk or ride your bike and count how many trees you see!	Tell someone about something you just read. Did you like it? Why or why not?	Draw outside with sidewalk chalk or water and a paintbrush.	Make a list of 5 places where you like to read.	Read a magazine.
Find some music you love and have a dance party.	Read anything you want to!	With siblings or friends, act out a favorite story or fairy tale.	Read a new book.	Look and see what the weather is like today. Predict what it will be like tomorrow and see if you're right!
Count how many blue cars go by in 5 minutes.	Make up a superhero name for yourself. What would your superpower be?	Read a poem. Try to write your own!	Attend a library program.	Find a fun recipe and try making it with a friend or family member.
Read a book from one of the displays at the library.	Hide something around the house and play the hot-or-cold game with a friend to find it.	Find a book you loved when you were younger and share it with a friend or sibling.	Sing a song from a movie you like.	Read something that's true (non-fiction).
Practice writing your name and the names of everyone in your family.	Read a book about something you love.	Have a snow ball fight with paper snow balls.	Find Freddie!	Tell a librarian a joke you learned.
Read something that is NOT a book!	Write your name and color it into a silly picture.	Read a fiction book.	Write a letter and mail it to someone!	Fill the sink or tub and see which household objects sink or float.
