

## **Policy on Appropriate Library Behavior**

Adopted July 1996 Affirmed October 2023

## **General Guidelines**

The Board of Trustees is committed to providing an atmosphere where people of all ages may enjoy the library. Prohibited behaviors include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Entering with concealed or openly visible firearms or other dangerous weapons, with the exception of those carried by authorized law enforcement agents
- Any action that disturbs others, interferes with library operations, or may cause damage to library property
- Smoking or vaping
- Having poor personal hygiene that offends others
- Speaking to other patrons or employees in an abusive manner
- Sleeping
- Bathing
- Not wearing a shirt and/or shoes
- Substance intoxication
- Profanity
- Depriving other patrons of the use of furniture or clear walking paths by leaving personal items unattended
- Panhandling
- Roughhousing

## Permitted only as part of library operations

- Remaining in the building after the library's closure
- Bringing animals into the building (service animals permitted)
- Eating in open areas (permitted in meeting rooms as appropriate)
- Soliciting, canvassing, or conducting surveys

Library employees ensure that these guidelines are upheld. Individuals refusing to comply will be asked to leave the premises.
